A Historical Tour of The National Iron & Steel Heritage Museum (formally known as Lukens Steel Company) is being offered for **Friday, October 5 at 11:00AM.**

Cost depends on the number of participants: up to 19 persons is \$12.00/ person, and up to 20 and more persons is \$10.00/ person.

Plan to arrive to the Executive Offices building by **10:45AM** to sign waivers and to enjoy a short power point presentation. Cost of the tour will be collected at that time, also. Arrive even earlier and you'll be able to enjoy the displays and art at the Lukens Executive Offices. The Executive Offices building opens at 10.00AM.

The tour takes approximately **90 minutes** and will include the Rolling Mill Complex, the Steel Workers' Memorial (which includes a steel "tree" from 9/11 which was made at Lukens), and the beautifully preserved Graystone Mansion. You may remember that Graystone Mansion was Coatesville's City Hall when we were students.

You will be asked to sign a waiver before the tour begins and closed toed shoes must be worn on the tour.
